6.	Landlord may show	w the premises to prospective te	nants during normal busiiness hours by first giving you
	written notice at least 24 hours in advance of the entry. The notice will be given to you in person, by leaving a copy		
	with an occupant o	of suitable age and discretion, or	by leaving the notice on or under your entry door.
7.	Notice: State law	permits former Tenants to reclair	abandoned personal property left at the former address of the
	Tenant, subject to	certain conditions. You may or m	ay not be able to reclaim property without incurring additional
	costs, depending of	on the cost of storing the property	and the length of time before it is reclaimed. In general, these
	costs will be lower the sooner you contact your former Landlord after being notified that property belonging		
	to you was left beh	nind after you moved out.
